Cheyenne National Cemetery is a new 5-acre Department of Veteran Affairs (VA) national cemetery located in the southeast portion of Wyoming. The cemetery will serve the burial needs of more than 55,000 Veterans, their spouses and eligible family members for the next 40 years. This number includes more than 15,000 Wyoming Veterans who will now be served with a VA burial option for the first time.

- This is the first national cemetery in Wyoming. The cemetery is managed by Fort Logan National Cemetery located in Denver, CO.
- In January 2017, VA purchased the land located southeast of the Department of Agriculture Research Center on Hildreth Road for \$64,099. The property is located in Laramie County.
- In the July 2018, VA awarded a design-build contract to Decatur Construction, Inc., a service-disabled Veteran-owned small business located in New Braunfels, Texas, to provide the design services and to complete the construction of the cemetery under one contract.
- The initial phase of construction will develop approximately 2.42 acres and provide for approximately 1,604 gravesites, accommodating both casketed and cremated remains. In addition to gravesites, the cemetery will include other features such as a front entrance off Hildreth Road, a columbarium and memorial plaque wall, a flagpole assembly area, a committal shelter, and a gravesite locator kiosk. Other cemetery infrastructure features will include roads, landscaping, and irrigation. When fully developed, Cheyenne National Cemetery will have a capacity of approximately 7,028 gravesites.
- Cemetery construction is currently under way and VA will hold a dedication ceremony October 8, 2020. First burials will take place in November.
